Reason for the nomination: Per precautionary principle. A quick view of the pictures show a wide disparity in sizes, backgrounds, techniques.... Only that is not enough for supporting this kind of deletion request. However, I invite you to a quick inspection of his last deleted pictures (only if being an admin, sorry). You will verify that the uploader took all of them from eBay (as the metadata showed), hosted them in one of his own sites, and claimed authorship (one of them was a screen shot from Youtube). The uploader's pattern is clearly exposed in File:Headshell.JPG. As mentioned, the image was taken from eBay (according to metadata). When I asked a speedy deletion on copyright grounds, Mcapdevila uploaded a different picture claiming that "New version of file bypasses the reasons for deletion request". However, a quick search showed that the version that "bypassed the reasons for deletion request" had been taken again from eBay. The original background had been removed, but it was clearly the same picture ([New version of file bypasses the reasons for deletion request here]).

Therefore, it's clear that @Mcapdevila: does not understand what free licenses and authorship mean and simply violates the copyright by using an own intermediate site. Thus, I do think all similar images are very likely another copyright violation and therefore must be deleted.
