Pain in the upper back that is a dull, one-sided ache, particularly if it is accompanied by fever and urinary symptoms may be real kidney pain. This may be due to a kidney infection, or a stone typically causes waves of sharp, intense pain, which doctors call renal colic. There's no sure way, do a urine test to find out. Sometimes you could have both together, this way the testing is very important.

For example, back pain may be associated with pain in the hip, buttock, or leg while kidney pain may be associated with fever and/or painful urination. Back pain may worsen with activity while kidney pain would not. Finally, back pain should ease off when lying down while kidney pain may not
