
Perry Index - Isop

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Faules d'Aesop, o l'Aesopica, és una col·lecció de faules acreditades a Aesop, un esclau i narrador que es creu que va viure a l'antiga Grècia entre el 620 i el 564 aC. D'orígens diversos, les històries associades al seu nom han descendit als temps moderns a través d'una sèrie de fonts i continuen sent reinterpretades en diferents registres verbals i en mitjans populars i artístics.

Les faules originalment pertanyien a la tradició oral i no van ser recollides durant uns tres segles després de la mort d'Aesop. En aquest moment se li van atribuir una varietat d'altres històries, acudits i refranys, encara que part d'aquest material era de fonts anteriors a ell o provenien de més enllà de l'esfera cultural grega. El procés d'inclusió s'ha continuat fins a l'actualitat, amb algunes de les faules no registrades abans de la Tardana Edat Mitjana i altres que arriben de fora d'Europa. El procés és continu i encara s'estan afegint noves històries al corpus Aesop, fins i tot quan són obra demostrablement més recent i de vegades d'autors coneguts.

L'índex perry és un índex molt utilitzat de "Fables d'Aesop" o "Aesopica", les faules atribuïdes a Aesop, el narrador que va viure a l'antiga Grècia entre el 620 i el 560 aC. L'índex ha estat creat per Ben Edwin Perry, professor de clàssics de la Universitat d'Illinois Urbana-Champaign.

L'erudició moderna considera que Aesop probablement no va compondre totes les faules que se li atribueixen; [1] De fet, se sap que alguns es van utilitzar per primera vegada abans que Aesop visqués, mentre que el primer registre que tenim de molts altres és de més d'un mil·lenni després del seu temps. Tradicionalment, les faules d'Aesop estaven ordenades alfabèticament, cosa que no és útil per al lector. [2] Perry els va enumerar per llengua (grec i després llatí), cronològicament, per font i després alfabèticament; l'erudit espanyol Francisco Rodríguez Adrados va crear un sistema similar. [2] Aquest sistema tampoc no ajuda el lector casual, però és el millor per a propòsits acadèmics. [2]
